Case Study:

For most of Eduardo's life he was unable to attend school due to the war that was raging in his native Angola. Now he feels lucky, however, as he is able to attend school and learn. His school is outside, usually under a tree that provides shelter from the sun. When it starts raining, they either run home or wait under the branches for it to stop. Their note books get wet and it's then difficult or even impossible sometimes, to use them.

Before he was able to go to school, his family lived in a forest, constantly on the run from soldiers. They didn't have any basic items on which to survive – no blankets, food, tents – but now Eduardo has a real chance of realising his dream of becoming a teacher.
