And fulfil these goals by:

- Setting out and monitoring objectives and targets of our organisation at least on an annual basis
- Communicating our environmental policy and performance on an annual basis to parties both internal and external to our organisation, and encourage constructive criticism and positive feedback
- Working together with our volunteers and partners to encourage commitment towards improved environmental performance
- Incorporating environmental considerations into the grants, events and services we provide
- Reviewing our environmental policy annually
